Motion to accept May, 2024 Minutes - Made by Robert Galati - Seconded by Angela Muchal. All in favor.

New Business

- Some new storm water projects are going around the storm water committee. Any new Storm Water related projects must be emailed to the storm water committee for awareness.
- The corner of Thomas and Palmer. There is a new home there. When it rains the road becomes a lake.

Minutes

- Reviewed all active projects
 1. JYSA Updates – Dennis Peters had a meeting with PennDOT to discuss existing sediment issues and scheduled a follow-up to discuss the insufficient berm.
 2. Brennan Street – No Response from Casey Barnes. Attorney Tunis is reaching out to the developer to see if they are allowing the easement. A cost has been provided to Sandi O for grants
 3. Bridge Street – project is in progress and going well.
 4. Ward Street – getting quotes for the paving that needs to be done.
 5. Blakely/Lane Streets (PEMA/FEMA project) – Denny provided documentation to Sandi O for grant resubmission. **No further updates.**
 6. 4th and Sturges, Second and Hands Streets (sewer) – Projects are combined into one, at cost of ~\$548,000. Waiting to hear about LSA grant awards. May be announced in September.
 7. 813 Lawler Dr.– Reached out to Sandi O for grant opportunities. **No further updates.**
 8. Winthrop Street . In Progress. Regular inspections are conducted and daily logs are kept. There has been a change form the initial outfall plan.
 9. Misc Inlet repairs – total of about 30 inlets. Costs have been provided for those being repaired versus replacing. If the costs are high we will seek a grant. Denny is in the process of setting a priority.
 10. Misc Projects – **(no further updates)**
 - a. Hill and Erie #1
 - b. Constitution and Lane #2
 - c. Constitution and Cherry #3
 - d. Clarkson and Mylert #4
 - e. Tonwin and Siniawa #5
 - f. Lane and 4TH #6
 11. Settler's View detention ponds - We have not been able to successfully contact the developer. We have not received an update from Attorney Tunis.

12. Hill and Constitution – Denny’s team is working on the plan and the permit that will be required. He also needs to see if we replace the existing drainpipe or move it.
13. Ferdinand Street– Still in the process of preparing the projects for bidding.
14. Olga Street – Still in the process of preparing the projects for bidding.
15. MaryJo Drive – Still in the process of preparing the projects for bidding.
16. MS4 – Will be submitted prior to September 30. We should have a draft by end of June.
17. Murray Ave – (between Spring and Blakely Streets / Grassy Island and Powell Avenues) DPW to install a swale to address drainage issues.
